Dear Sirs,

RE Carriage Agreement dated 9th March 2015 (the "Agreement") in respect of ShortsTV (the "Channel")

As we have recently discussed with you, we have taken the decision to move away from satellite delivery of ShortsTV to our US affiliates, following an internal review of our technical and delivery methods.

We intend to deliver our linear channel over IP using the proven, reliable and secure Zixi technology.

In order for your Participating Members to continue receiving the signal after the delivery change date, they will need to install Zixi-compliant, professional decoders/IRDs (for example Ateme DR5000 or Cisco D9800) or PC servers to run Zixi software. For each targeted device, they will need to provide 15Mbps internet connectivity and communicate the IP address of the device.


We'll cease satellite delivery of the signal on 20 August 2019. The goal is to implement and test the new system 30 days prior.

Our engineering team will work with the technical teams of Participating Members during installation, test and deployment.

If, upon consideration of this change and any possible cost effect on them, Participating Members elect to discontinue and terminate their distribution of the Channel, our Member Participation Agreement with them will terminate on date of the change of delivery (20 August 2019) as per clause 5.1 of the Agreement.
